

## Blanton Museum of Art Graduate Internship Program

The Blanton Museum of Art awards part-time, paid internships for University of Texas graduate students. Participants in the Internship Program will gain experience and knowledge within a museum environment and work on meaningful projects under the guidance of museum professionals. Some student interns, as University employees, may be eligible to participate in group insurance programs, may receive tuition benefits, and may qualify for certain other benefits in accordance with existing University policies. To apply for an internship, please submit the following:

- Cover letter including the applicant's name, home and university addresses, telephone numbers, email address, and departmental preference. If applying for more than one internship, please indicate order of preference.
- Full resume with education, employment history, and references
- Letter of recommendation
- Sample of academic writing
- One-page statement from the applicant regarding his or her interest in museum work and reasons for applying
- *Applications must be received by April 18th, 2008.*

In addition to the above opportunities, the museum occasionally offers flexible, unpaid graduate and undergraduate internships in a variety of departments.
