Graduate Internships

For UT graduate students only, the Blanton awards part-time, paid internships. Blanton Graduate Internships run with the academic calendar and are available for the Summer 2009 session as well as the 09/10 Long session. Graduate interns must meet employment requirements set by the Graduate School. Some graduate student interns, as UT employees, may be eligible to participate in insurance programs and may qualify for other benefits in accordance with existing university policies. Hours range from 10-20 hours a week. Compensation varies by appointment. Students from all academic and cultural backgrounds are encouraged to apply.

- Sample of academic writing (10 pages maximum).
- One page statement of interest regarding your academic and career goals.
