The Blanton offers a number of professional development opportunities for K-12 educators of all disciplines. Blanton in-services may be arranged at the museum or off-site and can be booked by the hour, or by theme. Both hourly and thematic in-services include a \$100 base rate for administration and materials. TEKS, ELPS, and SEL alignment will be addressed in all in-services.

Custom Tailored Hourly In-service

\$100 per hour for every 15 teachers

Recommended for K-12 educators with specific needs, custom in-services will be developed in consultation with your K-12 school or district contact to ensure goal alignment.

Thematic In-services

\$100 per hour for every 15 teachers

Each thematic in-service is two hours in length. Themes may be combined to create longer professional development experiences and may be tailored to meet
