DEPARTMENT: Prints, Drawings, and European Art

HOURS: 10–15/week
COMPENSATION: Unpaid

DESCRIPTION: The Department of Prints, Drawings, and European Art at the Blanton Museum of Art oversees approximately 13,500 prints and 1,500 drawings, ranging from the fifteenth century to the present, as well as about 300 European paintings from the fifteenth to the nineteenth century.

The intern will assist in research of the European paintings in the permanent collection and will provide support for other departmental needs. The summer internship is open to undergraduate and graduate students (not limited to those enrolled at The University of Texas at Austin).

REQUIREMENTS:

- Knowledge of European art, history, philosophy, or literature (ca. 1350–1850)
- Excellent research skills and knowledge of research tools and databases
- Keen attention to detail
- Strong organizational skills

DUTIES:

- Assist in documentation and research of the European paintings in the permanent collection
- Assist in tasks related to upcoming exhibitions and installations
- Assist in other tasks as needed
