AUSTIN, Texas—January 5, 2017—The Blanton Museum of Art at The University of Texas at Austin announces its annual fundraising party, ***Art on the Edge***, to be held on the evening of **Saturday, March 11, 2017**. A highlight of the city's social season, *Art on the Edge* brings together local tastemakers, young professionals, creatives, art-lovers, and community leaders for a festive night in celebration of the Blanton's role as a vital cultural resource for the Austin community.

This black-tie soiree will take place in the Blanton's soaring Rapoport Atrium and art-filled galleries, and will feature live music and dancing from **Memphis Train Revue** and **DJ Mel**, an open bar with signature cocktails, complimentary light bites, fun in the photobooth, and more. Guests will be the first to preview ***Nina Katchadourian: Curiouser***, the Blanton's mid-career survey of the work of Brooklyn-based artist, Nina Katchadourian, one of the most exciting contemporary artists working today. They will also enjoy after-hours access to the museum's newly-renovated and reinstalled permanent collection galleries, scheduled to open in February. Additionally, for the first time, a limited number of VIP tickets will be available for purchase in 2017. VIP tickets will include perks such as access to an exclusive lounge featuring private bars, special treats, and other surprises throughout the evening.

Founded in 1963, the Blanton Museum of Art holds the largest public collection in Central Texas with nearly 18,000 objects. Recognized for its modern and contemporary American and Latin American art, Italian Renaissance and Baroque paintings, and encyclopedic collection of prints and drawings, the Blanton offers thought-provoking, visually arresting, and personally moving encounters with art.

The museum is located at the intersection of Martin Luther King Jr. Boulevard and Congress Avenue and is open Tuesday through Friday from 10–5, Saturday from 11–5, and Sunday from 1–5. Thursdays are free admission days and every third Thursday the museum is open until 9. Admission Prices: Adults \$9, Kids 12 and under FREE, Seniors (65+) \$7, Youth/College Students (13–21) \$5.
