There's a lot to discover on the museum grounds, including plenty of Texas-sized works of art and architecture.

- Kick off your tour by visiting the Check-In lobby on your way to the Museum Store.
 Look up at the giant spectrum of colors.
 Head to the second floor to see it from above.
- ☐ Count how many petals—the big shade structures with holes in them—are on the museum grounds. (Hint: it's the same number of UT football games in the regular season.) In addition to helping cool the grounds, the petals collect rainwater and funnel it to irrigate the landscape.
- **Have a seat with your friends & family** and enjoy the view of the Texas State Capitol and *Austin* by Ellsworth Kelly, which is both a work of art and a building.
- ☐ Find the two murals on the museum grounds.

 One offers a very Texas-style welcome— from a
 Texan artist, no less! The other uses a color you
 may recognize from another Austin sports team.
- Relax on a bench beneath the oak trees of the Butler Sound Gallery. The artwork here is something you must listen carefully for. Do you recognize any Texas wildlife sounds?
