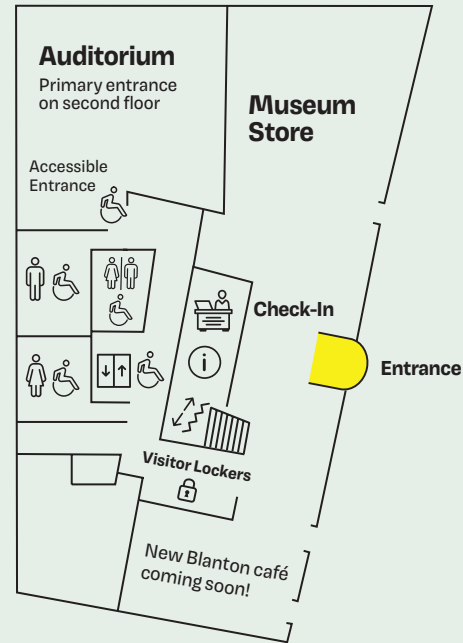

## Blanton All Day

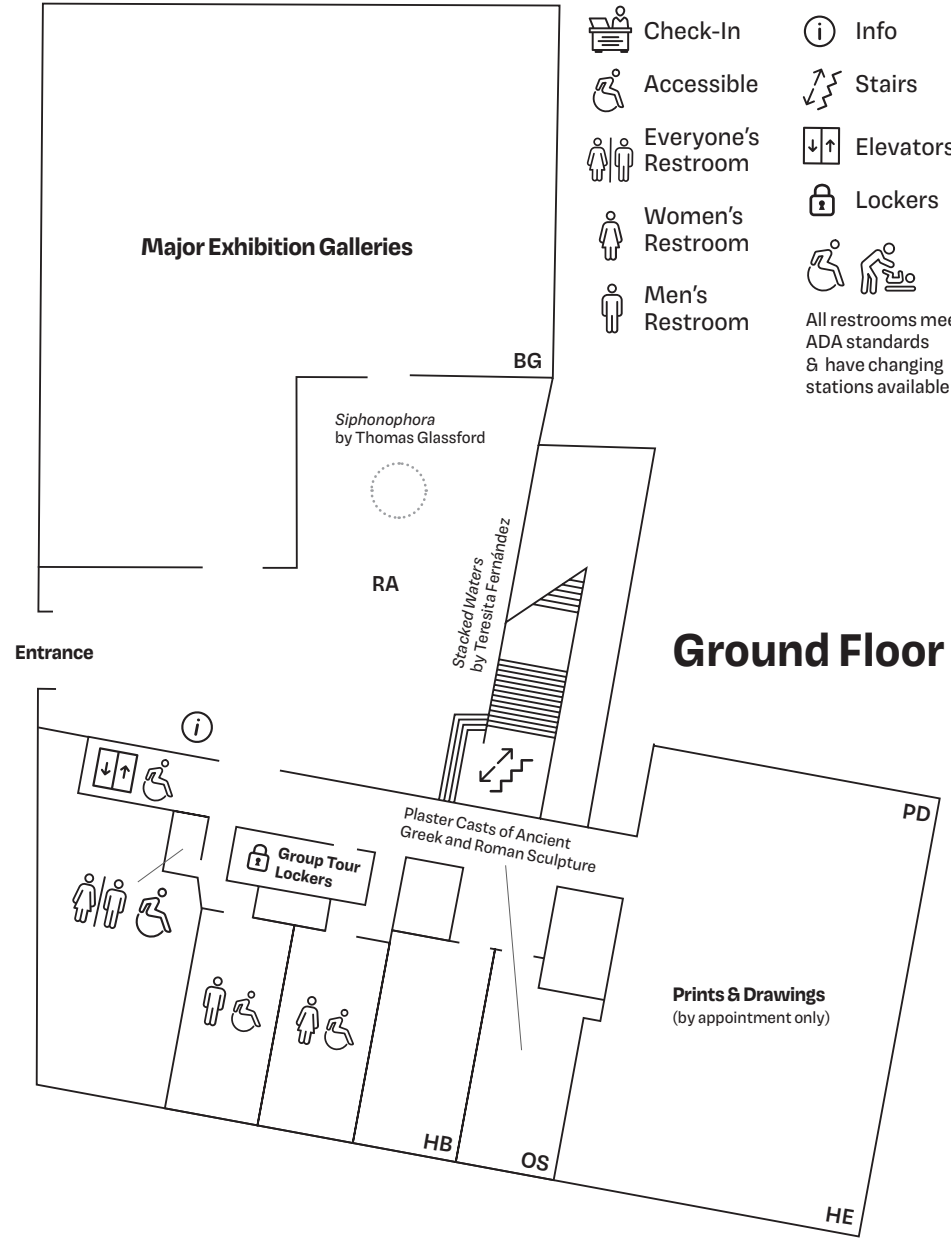
Every second weekend. Every month.

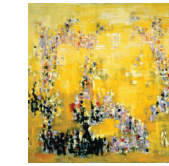

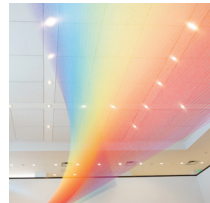

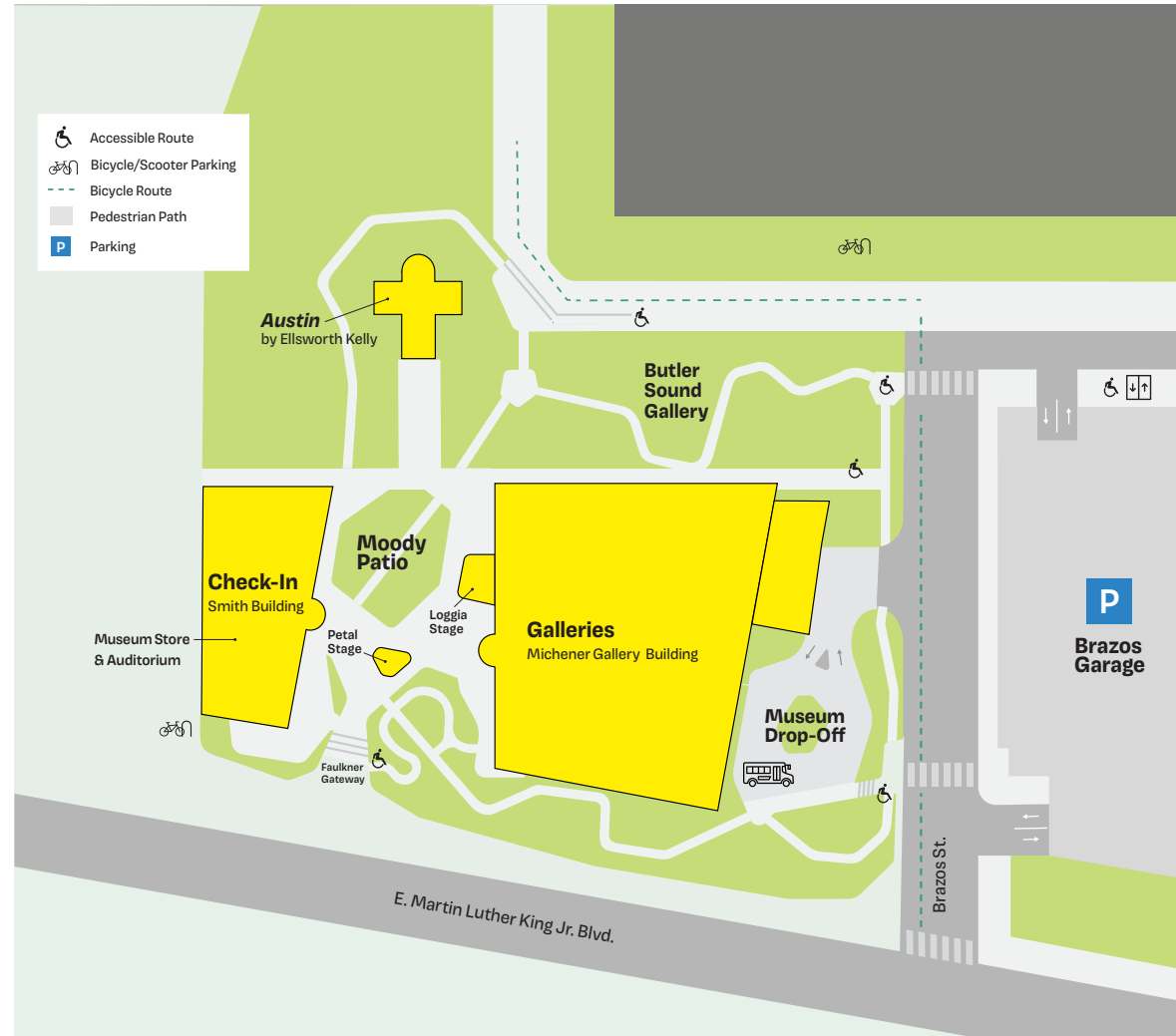
